Subject: Cost to Prepare the Administrative Record in the Costa Mesa Sanitary

District v. Regional Water Quality Control Board Litigation

Summary

This request asks the District to pay the cost to prepare the Administrative Record in the Costa Mesa Sanitary District v. Regional Water Quality Control Board litigation. The Board has already authorized this litigation, this request merely asks approval to pay the cost of the record which is necessary to proceed to trial.

Staff Recommendation

That the Board of Directors approves paying the administrative record cost of \$7,070.00

Analysis

CMSD has challenged the decision of the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) imposing a fine on CMSD arising out of the sanitary sewer overflows at Irvine Pump Station on August 31, 2013 and from the Indus pipeline on January 1, 2015. To challenge that fine, the District was required to file a Petition for Administrative Mandamus. The trial in a Petition for Administrative Mandamus is based on the record produced in a lower tribunal. In this case, the lower tribunal was the hearing conducted before the RWQCB, which occurred at the Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) headquarters. The record has now been prepared and we have received an itemized bill for those services (attached).

Although Respondent (RWQCB) is responsible for preserving and creating the record, the Petitioner (CMSD) is responsible for paying for the cost of preparing the record in the first instance. If we prevail, we are entitled to be recover our "costs" which include



the cost to prepare the record. Of course, if we do not prevail, we will not recover those costs.

The cost for the record is \$7,070 as shown on the attached invoice. We also ask for an additional sum to obtain a hard copy, which is what the court wants; however, the sum is unknown at this time.

Legal Review

District Counsel has prepared this report.

Environmental Review

Preparing an administrative record is an administrative matter and is not a disturbance of the environment similar to grading or construction and is not a project under CEQA or the District's CEQA Guidelines.

Financial Review

Funding for the administrative record cost is not budgeted; however, there is sufficient money in the current legal budget. This expense would be charged entirely to the Wastewater Fund.

Copies of this report are on file and will be included with the complete agenda packet for the August 25 2016 Board of Directors meeting at District Headquarters and posted on the District's website.

Alternative Action

1. Abandon the litigation and dismiss the Petition.
